## **Chief Operations Officer**

## **Roles and Responsibilities:**

- 1. Responsible for the governance of operational risks.
- 2. Provide inputs to CRO to define risk threshold and risk appetite
- 3. Define and delegate roles to the key personnel within the operations function for identifying and reporting risks
- 4. Provide relevant information to CRO regarding the risk reports
- 5. Identify, analyse and report relevant functional risks to the CRO and CEO along with recommended action plan
- 6. Ensure escalation of such incidents as per the escalation matrix approved by CRO.
- 7. Perform adequate due diligence of outsourced vendors prior to on-boarding
- 8. Identify, analyse and report relevant functional risks to the CRO and CEO along with recommended action plan
- 9. Ensure implementation of an integrated investment management system across front office, mid office and back office.
- 10. Ensure risk levels are in accordance to the approved risk threshold and risk metric.
- 11. Formulate, review and periodically provide inputs to update the RCSA for key risks and controls
- 12. Perform and report outcomes of periodic testing of the RCSA to CRO
- 13. Identify and implement corrective actions / recommend action plans for deviations in the controls and present to CRO/ CEO
- 14. Ensure adherence to the SEBI risk management framework
